

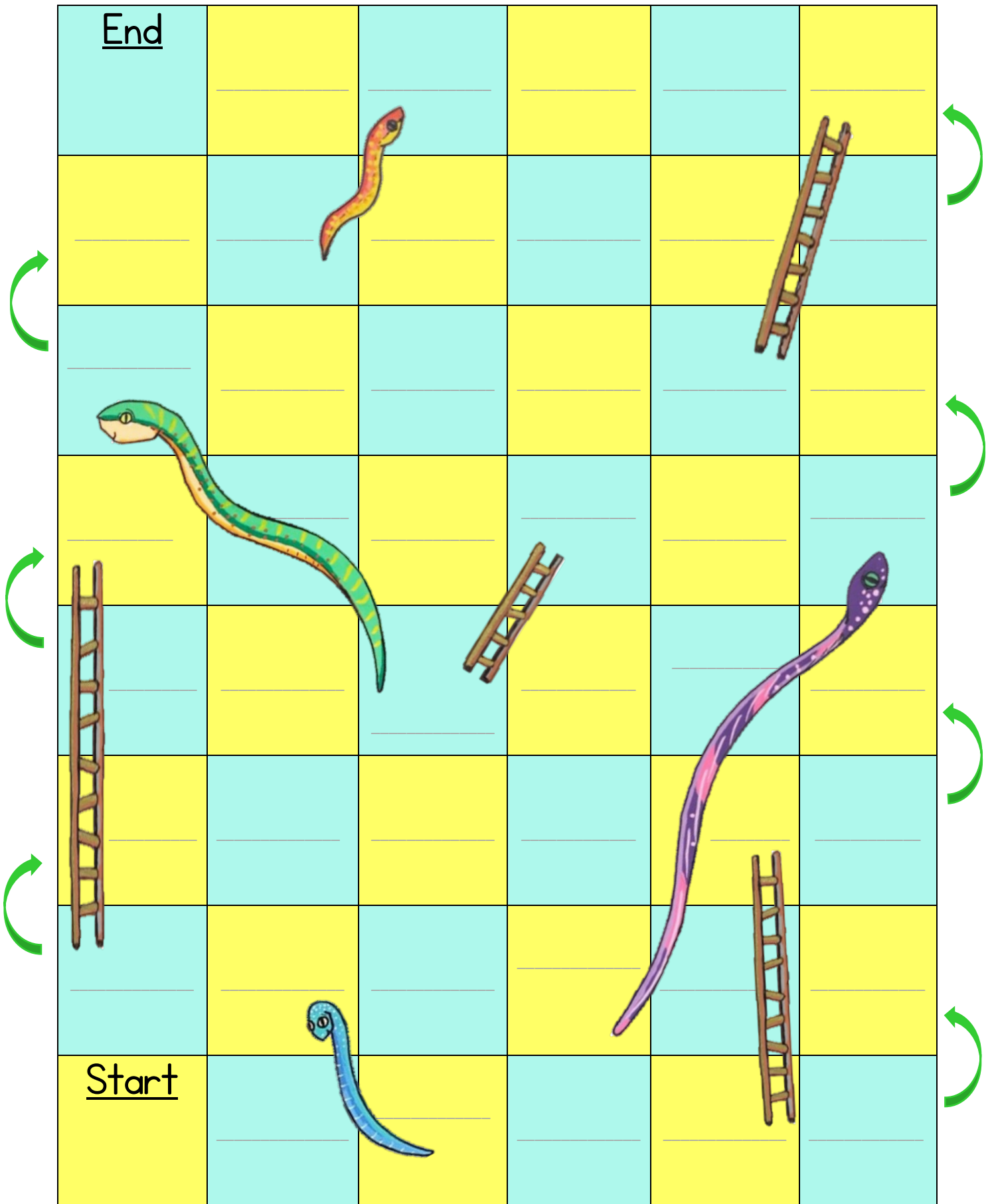
## Snakes and Ladders

The board features several snakes and ladders. Snakes are located at: (Dutch, much), (latch, stretch), (itch, catch), (etch, punch), and (hutch, notch). Ladders are located at: (French, Dutch), (etch, French), (glitch, rich), (sketch, bench), (hitch, Mitch), (conch, which), (punch, inch), and (latch, etch). Green arrows on the right side of the board indicate a clockwise direction of play.

Take turns rolling the dice and moving forward. If you land at the bottom of a ladder, go up. If you land on a snake head, slide down. Read each word you land on. First to the end, wins.

## Snakes and Ladders - Writing



Take turns rolling the dice and moving a counter or paperclip forward. If you land at the bottom of a ladder, go up. If you land on a snake head, slide down. Write a tch/ch word in each square you land on. First to the end, wins.
